
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC - 65

Coleoptera: Leiodidae

Leiodes rubiginosa (W. L. Schmidt, 1841). Bohemia or., Hradec Králové - Plachta (5861), 4.viii.1995, 3 spec., locality with sandy soil, covered by plant communities of the alliance Genistion Böcher 1943, association Cytisto supini - Callunetum Oberdorfer 1978, on light trap, M. Mikát lgt., Z. Švec det., coll. Museum of Eastern Bohemia (Hradec Králové), M. Mikát and Z. Švec (Praha). A psammophilous species that is distributed from Western and Central Europe to Denmark to Southern Sweden to Finland; reported also from Transbaicalia (Burakowski, Mroczkowski & Stefańska 1978). From Slovakia reported by Vávra (1996). Only one old and doubtful Bohemian record from Hvězda city park in Prague was given (Fleischer 1927-1930), the species was reported as doubtful also in the Check-list (Švec & Růžička 1993). Correction of the Check-list, occurrence confirmed in Bohemia.
