**FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 300**

---

**Coleoptera: Dermestidae**

*Attagenus (Attagenus) lobatus* Rosenhauer, 1856. Moravia mer., Jamolice (6963), 49°05'N 016°15'E, 380 m, former domestic airport ca. 1 km N of the village, 9.iv.–17.vi.2009, 1 ♀, pitfall trap baited with fish and cheese, with ethylene glycol as preservative, adjacent to a burrow of the ground squirrel *Spermophilus citellus* (Linnaeus, 1766), D. Král & J. Růžička leg., J. Háva det. and coll. Also collected in the trap were several specimens of *Dermestes (Dermestinus) lanarius lanarius* Illiger, 1802 (Dermestidae). Sifting in a nearby burrow of *S. citellus* on 9.iv.2009 produced a single male of *Attagenus smirnovi* Zhantiev, 1973 (Dermestidae).

*Attagenus lobatus* is known from Europe (Bulgaria, France, Greece, Italy, Romania, Russia, Spain and Turkey), North Africa (Algeria, Egypt, Morocco and Tunisia), Asia (Afghanistan, China (Beijing and Xinjiang), India (Uttar Pradesh), Iran, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, Saudi Arabia, Tajikistan, Turkey, Turkmenistan, United Arab Emirates and Uzbekistan) and North America (USA) (Háva 2007, Kadej 2010). This species is recognized as a serious pest of woollen goods in India (Veera et al. 1991). Both *A. lobatus* and *A. smirnovi* (another introduced and pest species already established in the Czech Republic since 1985, Vávra (2006)) are probably good fliers and able to actively reach the locality from the nearby village; the locality is also crossed by a field road with frequent movement of residents and tourists, a possible means of passive transport. New species for the Czech Republic and central Europe, probably accidentally introduced species.
