

FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC - 66

Coleoptera: Bothrideridae

Anommatus reitteri Ganglbauer, 1899. Bohemia centr., Praha - Břevnov, Kajetánka (5952a), 12.iv.1992, 1 spec. sifted in old city park, J. Růžička lgt. et coll.; Moravia bor., Hukvaldy (6375), 12.x.1996, 1 spec. sifted from cavity in living stem of *Tilia* sp., J. Vávra lgt. et coll. Both specimens R. Schuh (Katzelsdorf, Austria) det. Species distributed in southern part of Central Europe and throughout the Balkan Peninsula, in Central Europe rarely collected in Austria, Hungary and Slovakia (Dajoz 1977, Burakowski, Mroczkowski & Stefańska 1986), one old unreliable record known from Southwestern Poland (Burakowski, Mroczkowski & Stefańska 1986), recently introduced also to Germany (Schuh, pers. comm.). New species for the Czech Republic.
